Text to speech

- [ClaroRead](#) [20] - MAC & Win - is the primary component of the ClaroRead suite and has a text to speech feature. It is available at no cost from ITS.
- [Windows 10 has Narrator](#) [21].
- The macOS has the VoiceOver text-to-speech feature built into the operating system: look in System Preferences, Accessibility, VoiceOver for options.
- [Immersive Reader](#) [22] is part of the Learning Tools suite and is available in [Word](#), [Word Online](#) [23], [OneNote](#), [OneNote Online](#) [24], Outlook Online, and [Microsoft Edge](#) [25].
- [Natural Reader Online](#) [26] is free and reads many types of documents including DOC, TXT, PDF. Word Talk is a free Word plugin, which also allows saving to MP3 which can be listened to anywhere.
